HAITI - PROJECT TO SUPPORT THE REFORM OF THE TAX ADMINISTRATION AND AT THE COURT OF AUDITORS

2016-2018 - EU (€ 2 Mn) 2017-2019 - WORLD BANK (541 000 €)

Increase tax revenues and improve the performance of the Directorate-General of Taxes, by adapting its legislative and regulatory system, and building its capacities and its communication.

Support for the reform of the organisation of the Court of Auditors and Administrative Litigation (CSCCA), with the aim of strengthening it in the performance of its jurisdictional functions.

2016-2020 - EU (€ 7,9 Mn)

Support for the economic recovery by developing entrepreneurship, and improving access to financing for SMEs and the business environment.

2013-2016 - FRANCE (€ 2 Mn)

PAN AFRICAN STATISTICS PROGRAMME

2016-2018 - EU (€ 6,8 Mn)

Improve the collection, production and dissemination of high-quality statistics in Africa and strengthen coordination between all African actors working on the production of official statistics, at the national, regional and continental levels.

Support the project to create the African Union Institute for Statistics.
