France has adopted a global health strategy (2017-2022) which provides a reference framework and crosscutting approach to health issues. This strategy focuses on a rightsbased approach: health as a human right.

Expertise France, France's international operator, is fully in line with this strategy by acting as a lead contractor for French and Francophone expertise, with the aim of meeting requests made by partner countries.

To meet these needs, the agency's Health Department mobilises both internal and external technical expertise, from the public sector (particularly French health agencies), but also associations and the private sector.
