AN AMBITION

It is now urgent to reverse biodiversity decline before 2030 and to restore nature by 2050.

The parties to the **Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)** committed to it when adopting the **Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KMGBF)** in December 2022. These countries have thus affirmed a strong ambition, which must make possible the emergence of a world living in harmony with nature.

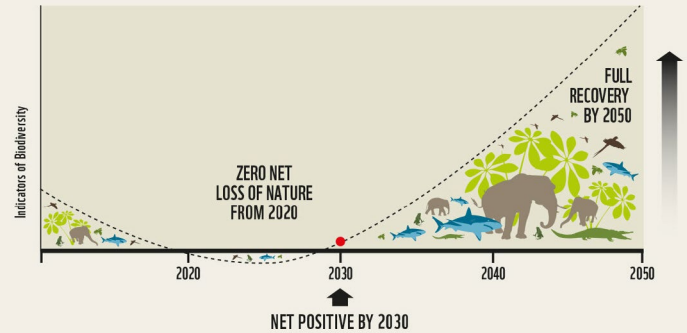
To address this situation, the **BIODEV2030** project was launched at the end of 2019 to contribute to biodiversity mainstreaming within the economic development strategies of 15 pilot countries.

A PROJECT

Implemented by IUCN and WWF-France, coordinated by Expertise France and funded by the AFD, the BIODEV2030 project suggests an innovative approach of biodiversity mainstreaming, based on science and multi-stakeholder dialogue.

BIODEV2030 thus contributes to the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Biodiversity Framework in 15 countries.
