





Jordan has mobilised considerable resources in the last decade to secure its northern and eastern borders with Syria and Iraq to cope with security threats.

This project consists of the construction of a logistical and administrative hub in Al Ruweished, Mafraq governorate, towards the Iraqi and Syrian borders and the provision of trainings in logistics and CIMIC.

The project intends to have positive impacts by:

- Reducing maintenance and logistical chains between Zarqa and Ruweished
- Supporting Jordanians authorities to quickly react to humanitarian crisis or security threats
- Supporting economic and social recovery of the region

This administrative and logistical hub will be the backbone to achieve the objective of improving civil-military coordination efforts in the region, Al Ruweished being an impoverished area and a traditional trade and migration route between Iraq and Jordan. It will notably host liaison offices for law enforcement and security agencies, a situational room, and a humanitarian hangar.

The European Union delegated to Expertise France, the French International Technical Cooperation Agency, the implementation of the 6 million euros project "Reinforcing Jordan capabilities at the Eastern borders". It will contribute to the larger Integrated Border Management programme of the European Union to support Jordan in improving the management of the borders.




